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New Fire Hydrants and Tanker Fire Truck Filling Station
MCWD is installing new infrastructure to support wildfire suppression.

Mammoth Lakes, California – The Mammoth Community Water District (District) is helping to strengthen the community’s wildfire preparedness and emergency response capabilities by installing two new fire hydrants and a tanker fire truck filling station. This new infrastructure will provide additional water access to support wildfire suppression.

One new fire hydrant will be installed along the Mammoth Scenic Loop, approximately 0.7 miles from the intersection of Highway 203. A second hydrant will be installed adjacent to the Twin Lakes Vista on Lake Mary Road. The District will also install a tanker fire truck filling station near its Lake Mary Water Treatment facility.

“These improvements are an important investment in our community’s emergency preparedness,” said Clay Murray, District General Manager. “By working collaboratively with our local fire department, we are helping to ensure that critical water resources are available where they are needed most.”

Installation of each asset is expected to take approximately one to two weeks in August and September. District staff will complete the work, and no significant impacts to the community are anticipated during construction.

MCWD coordinated with the Mammoth Lakes Fire Protection District, the Town of Mammoth Lakes, and the U.S. Forest Service to help make this project possible. This collaborative effort reflects a shared commitment to strengthening wildfire response capabilities and enhancing the protection of the Mammoth Lakes community.
